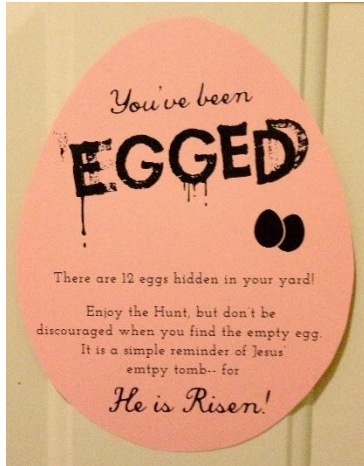


You've Been Egged!
