Attention Seniors: Coppedge Scholarship We are now accepting applications for the Hallie D. Coppedge Memorial Scholarship. Mrs. Coppedge was a member of Wake Forest Baptist Church where she served as deacon, choir member, personnel, and in many other capacities. She had a love for WFBC and wanted to encourage our youth. To qualify the recipient must be:

1. A Christian;
2. An active member of the Youth Choir of WFBC;
3. A member or watch care member of WFBC and involved in its youth ministry for the two years prior to the award (active Junior and Senior year unless recently moved to Wake Forest, then must be active entire Senior year);
4. A high school graduating Senior with acceptable grade point average;
5. Agree to use the award to further his/her education.

Applicants need to provide the following:

1. Spiritual Formation Paper (due Sunday, May 15, 2022)
Subject: Christian testimony, faith experience, and plans/calling for the future.
Address questions such as:
 - a. When did you become a Christian?
 - b. What are your plans at this point?
 - c. What are the most important things in your Christian journey so far?
 - d. Who is the most influential person in your life?
 - e. What contributions do you hope to make?
2. School Transcripts (due Sunday, May 15, 2022)
3. Interview—each applicant will be interviewed for 15-20 minutes by the Coppedge Award Committee in May.

If you would like to be considered for the scholarship, please submit Spiritual Formations paper and transcripts no later than May 15 to Bryant Moxley. Follow-up interviews will be scheduled once items are received.
