History:

The Dana Alexandra Jordan Scholarship Fund was established in 2007 by Dr. and Mrs. George and Joan Braswell to celebrate the legacy of their granddaughter, Dana Alexandra Jordan. Dana was a remarkable, exceptional young lady who touched the lives of countless family and friends. Because Dana would never be able to go to college, her grandparents and many others who have contributed to this fund have desired to award this scholarship as a means to encourage other young people to achieve their dreams through a college education.

Purpose:

The Dana Alexandra Jordan Scholarship Fund exists to aid young adults and their families by providing financial aid for higher education. An award of \$2000 will be granted each spring.

Qualifications:

A scholarship may be applied for by any young adult entering or returning to college who has been a member of Wake Forest Baptist Church for at least two years and an active participant in the church's youth ministry. The scholarship will be awarded based on evidence of Christian commitment, financial need, previous academic performance, with a special priority given to any student who has a passion similar to Dana's.

Process:

Young adults wishing to apply for a scholarship should complete the attached form and turn it in by May 15, 2022 to leah.harlow@wakeforestbaptistchurch.org.

Expectations:

- It is expected that students receiving financial aid through this scholarship will endeavor to do their best academically and to live out their Christian faith on campus so as to be a witness to Christ.
- Scholarship recipients are also expected to participate in the life of the church when home.

3. School Transcripts- due Sunday, May 15, 2022.
4. Please list any other scholarships you have applied for, or been awarded.
5. What are your plans for next year? Do you plan to attend college? Where?
6. Please describe your community service and volunteer activities.
7. What do you plan to study in school? What are your career objectives and goals?
